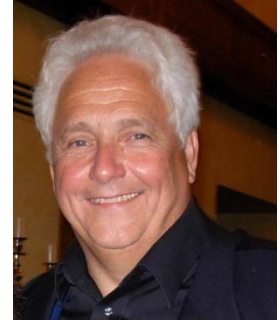

William R. Potter, M.S.

Mr. Potter is a retired scientist who earned his M.A. from the State University of New York at Buffalo (SUNY) in Physics in 1966. After he completed his graduate work in the Physics Department at SUNY, he joined Roswell Park Cancer Institute where he worked in the Biophysics Department, the Biological Resources Department, and finally the Department of Molecular & Cellular Biophysics (formerly the Division of Radiation Biology).

Mr. Potter has contributed to scores of published manuscripts relating to photodynamic and photoradiation therapies in the treatment and study of advanced carcinoma. He also has nearly 20 related patents to his credit.

Mr. Potter sits on Photolitec's Advisory Board. He also serves as Treasurer and a member of the governing board of the Cancer Wellness Center (CWC). As part of his volunteer work with the CWC, he teaches medical students "How to Deliver Bad News Compassionately". This innovative program was described in a paper published by the CWC in the Journal of Palliative Medicine and is a mandatory course for second year students at UB Medical School.

He also teaches an Astronomy course for the Physics Department at Niagara County Community College.

In the summers he races his sailboat with Buffalo Harbor Sailing Club.
